WHAT IS LSEM?

Lutheran Special Education Ministries (LSEM) is a non-profit organization that helps students with various academic needs work to their potential in the private school setting. LSEM has teachers around the United States fulfilling various positions in special education, from Pre-K through high school in both resource room and gifted/talented settings.

LSEM AT LUTHERAN NORTH

At Lutheran North, a Learning Coordinator works alongside the general education teachers to implement certain accommodations in the classroom. The Learning Coordinator offers test support in a designated classroom that is available to students throughout the day.

PROGRAM HGHLIGHTS

- A designated LSEM room that is available to students for test support as well as other
- academic needs throughout the day

 Structured Learning class where students get more guidance on homework from the teacher as well as mini lessons to help with skills such as test taking, essay writing, and organizational
- Peer-led tutors that will work with your student one-on-one in a subject they need to improve on. Peer tutors are available during study halls, before and after school
- Foundational classes offered to 9th graders in English, Math, and Science
- Work closely with surrounding public and private schools on transitioning pre-existing IEPs and accommodation plans (504s)
- Special education assessment available upon referral through Utica Community Schools

LSEM RESTRICTIONS

- LSEM Learning Coordinator does not direct teach but offers support through the accommodation plan implemented by the general education teachers
- The LSEM accommodation plan is not legally binding and is not attached to a public school IEP
- The LSEM program does not guarantee academic success but encourages students to work to their God-given abilities
- LSEM does not modify Lutheran North's curriculum
